1 Confidential minutes of the meeting on 24 January 2012

The confidential minutes of the Board meeting held on 24 January 2012 were approved and signed as a correct record. There were no matters arising.

2 Meeting review

Risk issues: It was noted there were risks associated with the quasi-judicial nature of the closure panel and the need to avoid discussing opinions about the closure before the hearing. Similarly there were risks during the pre-election period about the potential for members to make prejudicial comments. Members and officers were reminded of the importance of not making prejudicial comments in the run-up to the London election.

It was noted that there was a risk to delivery of London TravelWatch's objectives because of the need to relocate offices and hold the Watford closure panel before the Olympics. It was noted that London TravelWatch would not be considering an office move in the period immediately prior to the Olympics if not for the London Assembly review of the organisation.

Media: It was agreed that media activity would need to be low-level during the preelection period. However, work could be done on the Watford closure process and on London TravelWatch's role during the Olympics.
