## The problem

Present walking route along Euston Road is -

Busy
Noisy
Dirty (traffic fumes)
Crosses very busy traffic junction (Euston)


Access at Euston is step-free (but via a narrow passage into busy bus station) or via steep stairs








## Proposed route

From Euston via platform 1 to Eversholt St., then north to go down Phoenix Road and Brill Place, into St. Pancras on west side by FCC gateline





## Suggested step-free route to Eversholt Street




## Continue along Brill Place – which needs a fair bit of work

St. Pancras in sight at the end -








#### Cross Midland Road and turn right

Entrance to St. Pancras is between the two taxis -








Turn left for First Capital Connect to East Croydon, Gatwick Airport, Luton Airport –

(Easier than struggling by LUL Euston – Victoria for Croydon / Gatwick / Brighton ?)




Right, then left for Eurostar






Straight on, then left, for Southeastern High Speed 1 trains to Stratford and Kent -

Supported by London TravelWatch

Support from London Borough Camden at officer level – will bid into 2010 / 11 budget for street improvements, and will bid for TfL money on walking initiatives

Idea shown to senior Eurostar and Southeastern managers – favourable reaction

#### What's needed now?

Clear project leadership

DfT and TfL support

Rail industry to take "can do" ownership - must avoid possible "too difficult" reaction

(Many TOCs are potential beneficiaries of easier Euston – St. Pancras / Kings Cross interchange)

Buy-in by LB Camden at councillor level
